in-session modalities, recommendations for moderators/speakers/ discussants and slides preparation

in-congress consists of 14 in-sessions. 6 in-key honorary lectures, 2 industry focuses and an *in*-innovation challenge at the end of the congress. Each one-hour in-session is made of 4 presentations with 2 moderators, 4 speakers and 4 discussants. Each speaker has 8 minutes to present their slides (slides in English, talk in Italian or English). At the beginning of each session discussants will sit at the panel table togheter with the moderators. At the end of each presentation 3 minutes will be dedicated to a short discussion between discussant and speaker: the discussant may ask up to 2 guestions to the speaker before moving on to the next presentation. At the end of the 4 presentations, the moderators will open the general discussion which will last up to 15 minutes and will be expected to ask questions and also to involve the audience in the discussion. The moderators will also be expected to rigorously oversee: if necessary, the general discussion will have to be shortened. A strict compliance with the presentation time for both speakers (8 minutes) and discussants (3 minutes) is strongly recommended: the speakers will be

notified at the end of the 8 minutes. At the exact ninth minute of the presentation the slides will disappear from the screen. In this case discussants, will be allowed to ask the speaker just one question.

Presentation video clips lasting 90 seconds of a procedure of one of the 4 speakers, will be broadcasted before each session according to the *in*-entertainment modalities. The *in*-key honorary lectures will have one moderator and one speaker and will last 15 minutes: in this time, moderators will be allowed to ask the speaker up to 2 questions. Industry focus sessions consist of 6 presentations each day for a total of 12 presentations (10 minutes), proposed by the companies and approved by the *in*-congress scientific committee.

Moderators of *in*-key honorary lectures and industry focuses must oversee to that presentation times are respected. Slides preparation must comply with the *in*-congress template: a maximum of 15 slides for the presentations and 30 slides for the *in*-key honorary lectures is highly recommended.

in-innovation challenge rules

in-innovation challenge has been conceived to increase the interest of attendees up to the very end of the *in*-congress. After a preliminary selection by the Faculty and presentations of the speakers, all attendees will be asked to vote for the most young innovative interventional communication, the most young innovative endovascular communication, the 2022-23 most innovative Italian interventional paper, the 2022-23 most innovative Italian endovascular paper.


The 4 best "innovators" will be finally awarded (see summary table of *in*-innovation challenge).

Innovative abstracts in English language must be sent by e-mail to massimo.venturini@uninsubria.it and federico.fontana@uninsubria.it for interventional; to matteo.tozzi@uninsubria.it and gabriele.piffaretti@uninsubria.it

for endovascular by June 30th. All corresponding authors-potential speakers must be 36-year-old or younger. Abstracts focused on innovation could involve up to 6 authors and consist of a maximum of 200 words (Background/Aim -Materials/Methods - Results - Conclusions). All interventional abstracts' authors will be blinded and sent out by Massimo Venturini and Federico Fontana to Marco Calandri (Torino), Francesco Giurazza (Napoli) and Pierleone Lucatelli (Roma), while all endovascular abstracts will be blinded and sent out by Matteo Tozzi and Gabriele Piffaretti to Filippo Benedetto (Messina), Mario D'Oria (Trieste) and Enrico Gallitto (Bologna). Each reviewer will choose their favourite abstract by July 15th. The 6 chosen abstracts will be presented in a 5-minute talk at the *in*-congress by the corresponding/first author (for slides preparation please use the *in*-congress template and the English language, talk in Italian or English).

Gianpaolo Carrafiello (Milano), Francesco De Cobelli (Milano) and Rita Golfieri (Bologna) will select the 2022-23 best innovative Italian interventional paper, while Michele Antonello (Padova), Mauro Gargiulo (Bologna) and Santi Trimarchi (Milano) the 2022-23 best innovative Italian endovascular paper. At the *in*-congress the two selection committes will have 3 minutes to explain the reasons for their choice (1-3 slides, one with the title page of the selected paper published on PubMed). Subsequently the audience will vote for the "4 best innovators" and they will be each awarded by their sponsor (review er or professor). Any conflict of interest will be avoided by excluding abstracts-papers of the institutions/hospitals of origin of the reviewers/professors from their specific competition. In this final part of the in-congress, the moderators will also be expected to rigorously oversee that presentation timings are respected (in-innovation challenge does not include discussions).
